This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the 6th DAY of April - Two Thousand and Twenty Two (06/04/2022), by and between

AGV Systems Private Limited with registered office at F-2, F-wing, Udyog Bhavan No.2, Plot No. K1, MIDC Additional Ambarnath Area, Village Jambhivali, Ambarnath (E), Thane, Maharashtra, India 421506. GSTIN No: 27AAHCA3727G1ZR represented by its Chairman and Director R&D Dr. Kushal Tuckley [hereinafter referred as 'First Party' (PARTY 1)].

AND

M.H.Sabbo Siddik College of Engineering, Byculla, Mumbai-08, Department of EXTC with GSTIN No: 27AABTM6917D2ZL as THE SECOND PARTY represented herein by its (HOD/Dean Name/VC)[hereinafter referred to as "Second Party" (PARTY 2)]. The Second Party is seeking Internet of Things (IOT) training services which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors - in-office, administrators and assigns). (First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'PARTIES' and individually as 'Party') as

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Purpose of the AGREEMENT & MOU

This Agreement is entered between both the PARTIES in good faith, where the First Party undertakes initiative to educate the Students, as intern/trainee in the field of Embedded System Development and IoT Hardware and to inculcate practical knowledge by utilizing the facilities and contributing in the activities of 'First Party'

2. Scope and Terms of Interactions of the MOU

For the purpose of this Agreement - MOU, the term "the Disclosing Party" shall be the PARTY 1 that discloses confidential information to the Receiving Party and the term "the Recipient" shall be the PARTY 2 that receives Confidential Information from the Disclosing Party. The PARTY 2 will share with PARTY 1 only such information like, name, email and mobile number towards having the students get enrolled. Both PARTY 1 and PARTY 2 shall encourage interactions between the Engineers from Party 1, Faculty members and Students from Party 2 through the following arrangements:

- a) Practical/ Internship training of PARTY 2 students and staff with respect to the selected project/ activity.
- b) Party 1 shall provide the training/ offer project only to the eligible students of party 2.
- c) Guiding students of PARTY 2 towards their participation in the Electronics
- d) In any of the activities mentioned above, wherever financial aspects are involved, amount, payment conditions, etc. would be spelt out clearly before starting the activity. PARTY 1 will raise a Quotation with costs on case-to-case basis. The activity shall commence once the Quotation is approved and signed with seal by PARTY 2.

3. Confidentiality and IPR

"Confidential information" shall mean all such information that comprise of "Intellectual Proprietary Rights" of the PARTY 1 including but not limited to terms of this Agreement, data or facts collectively or severally, disclosed by the disclosing party under this agreement or any subsequent agreement, whether in writing, verbal or electronically, irrespective of the medium in which such information is stored, which is marked confidential or with any other words having similar meaning by the disclosing party, or specifically agreed to be kept confidential by the PARTY 2, or declared or identified so by the disclosing party before such disclosure or during the discussions.

4. Amendments

Any amendment and/or addenda / annexure to the AGREEMENT shall be in writing and signed by both the PARTIES hereto and shall only after such execution be deemed to form part of the AGREEMENT and have the effect of modifying the AGREEMENT to the extent required by such amendment or addenda.

5. Effective date and Duration of the MOU

- a) This MOU is signed on 6th April 2022 and shall be effective from the date of signing of both PARTY 1 and PARTY 2 by competent authorities at both ends.
- b) The duration of the MOU shall be for a period of one year (12 calendar months) from the effective date.
- c) Any clause or terms of the MOU may be modified or amended by mutual agreement of PARTY 1 and PARTY 2 in writing.

6. Resolution of Disputes

- a) This agreement shall take effect and be construed in accordance with the Laws of India and be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts in Mumbai, Maharashtra - India.
- b) The dispute or difference whatsoever arises between the PARTIES in relation to or in connection with this AGREEMENT both the PARTIES shall first try to resolve the dispute/difference amicably between themselves, failing which the matter shall be referred to and settled through arbitration. The arbitration proceedings shall be held in accordance

with the provision of Indian Arbitration and Reconciliation ACT, 1996. The venue of arbitration shall be Mumbai, Maharashtra, India and Language of arbitration shall be English.

7. Miscellaneous

- a) The headings and sub-headings are inserted for convenience only and shall not affect the construction of this Agreement.
- b) Both PARTY 1 and PARTY 2 shall not, during the term of this Agreement directly or indirectly, solicit or offer employment or engagement to any of the personnel of other party without the prior consent in writing of that other party.
- c) After this Agreement has been signed, all preceding understandings/ negotiations and correspondence pertaining to it shall become null and void.
- d) All obligations created by this Agreement shall survive change or termination of the PARTIES' business relationship for a period of no more than one (1) year.



- Required number of computer systems in the lab for the practical's.
- Class rooms with LCD projector for the theory classes.
- Schedule the classes for this training during normal working hours of the college.

- Required Training software will be available on computer systems.
- Disciplinary support for the smooth conduct and timely completion of the entire course.

PARTICIPANTS

COURSE CONTENTS


CADD Centre in consultation with M H Saboo Siddik College of Engineering has finalized the course contents for the Institutional Training Courses. These will be reviewed every year and suitable changes, if required, will be incorporated. As the requirement of each core engineering branch is different, course contents have been worked out separately for each branch & every year.

TIME SCHEDULE

The programme(s) will be conducted during the Institute working hours.
The students will be divided into batches, depending on the total strength.

LINK OFFICER

The Institute Representative shall appoint a Link Officer from each department for the duration of the programme, who shall liaise with CADD Centre and speak for the participants to make the training process learner-friendly and effective. CADD Centre shall work in close relationship with the Link Officer, who shall in-turn keep a close touch with the students. In the event of any difference of opinion between CADD Centre and the Link Officer, the matter should be referred to the Head of Department whose decision thereon shall be final.



COURSE FEES & PAYMENT PATTERN

The course fees per student for each one the courses offered is detailed at Annexure 2A.

The Students enrolled will be required to make the payments for the respective courses.

JURISDICTION

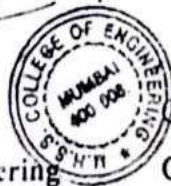



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (herein after called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the 21st day of February month 2022 (Date 21-02-2022),

by and between **ExcelR Solutions,**
(Here in after referred as 'First Party')

And

Anjuman-I-Islam's
M. H. Saboo Siddik College of Engineering

(Here in after referred to as 'Second Party')

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties'
and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS:

1. First Party is a EdTech company: ExcelR Solutions
2. First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
3. The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
4. Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

5. Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings.
6. First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to the second party in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
7. The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds, and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.
8. ExcelR would be the training delivery partner for the second party on various trending technologies.
9. ExcelR would be the training delivery partner for the student internships of second party on various trending technologies of minimum four weeks duration.
10. Training & Development and dissemination of knowledge for students of second party & affiliated colleges and employees of both the organizations.
11. ExcelR would work with incubation centers/ innovation cells of second party (Case to case basis), to formulate the business cases and data collection process from various industry and academic bodies that are associated with the second party

12. Cooperation between both parties would be extended to any other area which may be mutually beneficial to both the organizations.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

13. The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation, and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
14. Curriculum Design: First Party will give valuable inputs to the Second Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customise the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
15. Software Technologies Training: The first party will provide the trainings to the students and Faculties of the second party on different technologies like Data Science, Data Analyst, Artificial Intelligence, Tableau, Python, etc., Research and Development.
16. Skill Development Programs: First Party to train the students of second Party on the emerging technologies to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
17. Guest Lectures: First Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the second Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
18. Faculty Development Programs: First Party to train the faculties of second Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
19. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein.
20. There is no financial commitment on the part of the second party to enrol the students and faculties for the different free trainings run by the first party under Everyday Learning Initiation.

21. First party would extend the help in providing artifacts such as training records, certificates to the second party upon a written request from the second party. This information is limited to only the students of second party and at the discretion of first party.
22. In case, second party wants to conduct customized commercial trainings then this agreement can be amend/adding annexure with mutually agreed terms.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

23. The first party will have the sole rights on the curriculum and related content provided in the trainings and it cannot be replicated or copied without the consent of the first party.
24. Confidentiality: Except as may otherwise be required by law, each party will hold confidential, during and after the term of this Agreement, any confidential information disclosed to it or its representatives, and will not disclose any such confidential information to any third party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY


25. The period of the agreement is valid for a period of 1 year from the date of signing of this agreement
26. This agreement will be valid only at the intentions of the parties involved therein, this MOU could be dissolved or cancelled by either party any time by giving 30 days' notice and shall not have any legal bindings in nature. should either or all the parties to it opt to not act upon, the MOU loses its validity.

27. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

2. Huawei Telecommunications (India) Co Pvt. Ltd., a company incorporated and existing under the laws of India and having its registered office at 11th Floor Capital Cyberspace,Gurugram Manesar Urban Complex ,Sec-58 Ullahwas, Gurugram -122001, Haryana, India ("Huawei")

Each party is referred to in this Memorandum of Understanding as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

Recitals:

1. Whereas Institution desires to be appointed as ICT Academy of Huawei.
2. Huawei is considering the appointment of Institution as ICT Academy of Huawei.

The Parties agree as follows:

1. Objective

- 1.1 The Parties further to their discussion intends on the possibility of forming a cooperative relationship for the appointment of Institution as ICT Academy of Huawei. In order to facilitate this intention, the Institution has agreed to enter into the agreement (Annexure 1) with Huawei Technologies Co., Ltd. having its registered office at Huawei industrial Base, Bantian, Longang District, Shenzhen, P.R.China, and this agreement is under signature.
- 1.2 This Memorandum of Understanding is being signed between the parties to authorize the Institution to start the training batch for their students immediately and also assist the Institute to get support from Huawei for registering under ICT Academy of Huawei as per the terms and conditions agreed in the agreement.

2. Non-binding nature

- 2.1 The Parties agree that this Memorandum of Understanding, continuing discussion, future exchange of information, past or future correspondence or other communications between the Parties shall not commit either Party to continue discussion or negotiation nor shall such be legally binding as an informal agreement or agreement to agree to a potential
